We are thrilled to host our annual competitions that provide students the national platform to compete with students from different places, showcase their calculating skills, adept English knowledge, and the art of beautiful handwriting.

#### General guidelines for students

- Students must wear plain white shirt or T-shirt, white top, white chudidar or white kurta or white kurtis, with blue jeans or blue pants.
  - (Students wearing school uniform will not be allowed inside the Competition Hall)
- **▼ BATCH 1** students must reach venue before **9.15 AM**.
- Students coming late after the Reporting Time will not be allowed into Competition Hall.
- Parents/Teachers need to handover the students at GATE NO.1 (Students Entry).
- Students must carry ADMIT CARD, two or three lead pencils, a bottle of water inside the competition hall (Bags, erasers & tip pencils are not allowed)
- Pin the ADMIT CARD on your right hand sleeve.
- Once you are seated, check the ADMIT CARD NUMBER on your table and QUESTION PAPER.
- Don't write your name on the question paper. If so, you will be disqualified.
- You will be disqualified if you talk / call numbers / share answers in the Competition Hall.
- Hear all instructions and do as directed.
- Mobile phones are strictly prohibited inside the Competition Hall.
- Collect your Participation Certificate before exiting the Competition Hall.

#### Guidelines - The AJ'S ABACUS COMPETITION

- The competition is for **5 minutes**.
- Participants have to solve 70 sums.
- Write all answers clearly and legibly. Don't smudge or overwrite on the wrong answer.
- If any mistakes made, just rewrite the correct answer below it.
- Students can solve the sums using Finger Method, Abacus Method or Mind Maths method.

#### Guidelines - The AJ'S HANDWRITING COMPETITION

- The competition is for 20 minutes.
- The participant can write in Print or Cursive form.
- Grade 3 & 4 Use pencil, gel pen or ink pen only.
- Grade 5 & 12 Use gel, ink or ballpoint pens only.
- If any mistakes done, strike off the wrong word & rewrite it. Smudging, erasing & overwriting will carry negative points.

#### **FOOD & GAMES**

- Carry enough water and food.
- No food will be provided.
- Private snacks counters will be available.
- Fun games & entertainments will be conducted

### **Award Cermony**

- The Award Ceremony starts at 4.00 pm same day.
- Students will be awarded Category wise Champion, Winner, 1<sup>st</sup> Runner Up, 2<sup>nd</sup> Runner Up & 3<sup>rd</sup> Runner Up.
- If the same award is a tie, all winning students will be felicitated on stage and a photograph will be taken with trophy. The trophy will be sent to respective school & Learning centres on or before 29.02.2025.
- The Award Ceremony closes at 6.00 pm same day.

# Guidelines for parents/teachers

- Parents/Teachers have to handover students at GATE NO.1 (Student Entry)
- Parents/Teachers must ensure that the child carries all needed things.
- Parents/Teachers are requested to advise the students not to talk / call numbers / share answers.
- Parents/Teachers are strictly not allowed inside the Competition Hall.
- Parents/Teachers are allowed to collect the child at GATE NO.2. (Parents Waiting Hall)
- Students are eligible to recheck the answer paper by paying Rs.200 for each stage. If any changes found, the rechecking fee will be refunded and the child will be given the award as deserved. To lodge a request mail to info@theajs.in with student's Admit card no.
- Parents/Teachers are requested to send your suggestions regarding any upgrades or lapses in the arrangements to info@theajs.in.
- No Suggesting or argument will not be entertained on the competition day, as it will divert the attention of staff from their duties.
